BOARD SELF-EVALUATION On a periodic basis, the Board shall plan and conduct a thorough self-evaluation. This evaluation may be conducted in a regular meeting, a special meeting, or in a workshop setting. The review may include an analysis of:

- 1. Board procedures.
- 2. Board member training.
- 3. Conflict resolution.
- 4. Working relationships with the College President.
- 5. Conduct of Board meetings.
- 6. Long-range planning and goal setting.
- 7. Relationship with the community.

On a periodic basis, the Board shall conduct a self-evaluation of Board and Board member performance. The evaluation may consider such items as role recognition, relationship with others, performance at Board meetings, and self-improvement activities. The procedure may also include a review of those factors that facilitate effective Board meetings. The Board may solicit suggestions for improvement from others through established College District communication channels.
