## ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET

BUDGET PLAN	The budget shall represent the approved educational plan of the College District for the academic year stated in fiscal terms. When considering budget issues, the Board shall adhere to the following principles:	
	1.	The budget shall reflect the best possible distribution of avail- able funds in accordance with the College District's master plan.
	2.	The budget shall identify sufficient sources of funds to ensure a fiscally balanced budget.
	3.	The budget shall provide contingencies adequate to meet reasonable unforeseen demands.
	4.	The budget shall include, where appropriate, funds from grants where such grants meet the conditions set forth in Board policies concerning the receipt of external funds.
	5.	The budget shall include, when available, funds for educa- tional and staff development.
BUDGET DEVELOPMENT	The College President shall develop procedures as necessary to ensure appropriate input from all College District levels of opera- tion in the development of a proposed expenditure plan for all Col- lege District funds in the ensuing fiscal year.	
BUDGET ADOPTION	Adoption of the budget by the Board shall constitute authority to expend funds for the purposes indicated and in accordance with approved policies of the College District.	
BUDGET AMENDMENT	The approved budget may be modified after adoption only by a ma- jority vote of all members of the Board.
